



Not only did he attend the festival, but he also applied his own percussion skills, accompanying the chorus on the conga drums in the final performance.

Mr. Lyons' greatest teaching asset is his genuine appreciation for his students. He shows them respect and the students enjoyed working with him. He was able to converse with the students on their level while teaching them effectively. He is very personable and exhibited his own interest in music, which helped to foster their love for the subject as well.
